The format envisages three to four sections, which will take place one after the other and not in parallel, so that all participants can hear all the presentations. Thematically, this symposium is focused on specific topics of this region.

The conference will comprehend on the current state and current trends in business history research in Austria, Germany and Italy. Comparative aspects between these countries form an essential component in this context.

- Business history and the Marshall Plan
- State influence on entrepreneurial activities and operational processes
- Economic transformations after the Second World War
